Venue Rental Fees

Minimum Rental

- 10 hours during Peak Season (April – October)
- 6 hours during Winter (November – March), weekdays, or weekend reservations booked within 3 months of the event date during Peak Season. The Live Oak Community Center and Valencia Hall require a 6-hour minimum year-round.
