

Quail Hollow Ranch 2019 – north is up, east is right



Changes from 1975 photo:

- Trees and chaparral have grown and filled in quite a bit of old pasture and orchard space. The space just north of the long driveway is being overtaken and the chaparral trail through it is largely shaded. The orchard east of the corrals is completely overgrown by mature trees. If you hike by there, look for the terraces.
- The Sunset trail now ends at a vista with a bench (top, just left of center) and the old extension has been replaced by a new trail (Woodrat) which you can see below the Sunset
- Pond is smaller; it has filled in somewhat and is nearly surrounded by Willows and other shrubbery
- Trees have overgrown most of the trails, so while the trails still exist, they are mostly covered in shade. The Italian trail is almost invisible in the photo. At the top, you can still see the end of the Sunset and Woodrat trails. The east side of Discovery (below the Quail Hollow Ranch County Park text) is still very visible.
- The sand quarry at the lower left/bottom (opened in 1972) is much bigger
